3. The corporation is incorporated under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1988 for the following purpose or purposes:

The corporation is organized for charitable purposes as set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law)(the "Code").

Attachment No. 2 to Articles of Incorporation – Nonprofit  
for Jamie's Kids

Additional Provisions of the Articles:

10. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any officer or director of the corporation or to any other private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes set forth herein.
11. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation organized and operated exclusively for exempt purposes and which is a public charity described in Section 509(a)(1),(2) or (3) of the Code.
12. The corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis and shall have no members. Rather, the business, property and affairs of the corporation shall be managed and controlled by its Board of Directors.
13. The term for which the corporation is to exist is perpetual.
14. In the event of the dissolution of the corporation or in the winding up of its affairs, or other liquidation of its assets, the corporation's property shall not be conveyed to any organization created or operated for profit or to any individual for less than the fair market value of such property; all assets remaining after all debts and expenses of the corporation have been paid or provided for shall be conveyed or distributed by the Board of Directors exclusively to one or more organizations qualifying for the exemption afforded by Section 501(c)(3) of the Code that, in the sole judgment of the Board of Directors, have purposes most closely aligned with those of the corporation. Any such assets not so distributed shall be disposed of pursuant to an order by a court of competent jurisdiction, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine. No private individual shall share in the distribution of any corporate assets upon dissolution of the corporation.



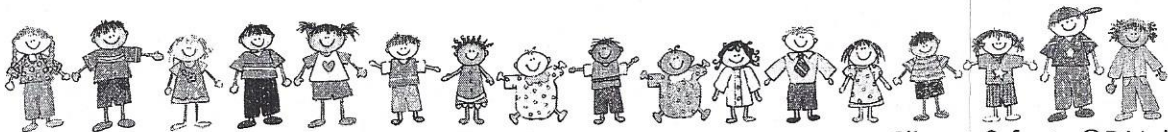
